The Sidney City Council met in regular session on Monday, January 11, 2010 at 6:00 pm at the city hall. Mayor Pro Tem, Henderson conducted the meeting. Members present: Henderson, Clark, Kersten, Jill Travis and Joe Travis. Absent: Mayor Hobbie. He arrived at 7:15 pm. Others present: Todd Poppie, Chief, Mark Travis, Manager and Suzanne Moores, City Clerk.

Motion to approve the agenda was made by Joe Travis, seconded by Bill Clark. Ayes: All.

Motion to approve the minutes was made by Jill Travis, seconded by Kersten. Ayes: All.

Sheriff Aistrophe and Deputy Hofich were present for the council to consider and possibly take action at the February meeting for donations for the New K-9 Dog. This dog and deputy are highly trained to be their Drug Dog for the Sheriff's Department. He will begin his 12 week training in March at Grand Island, Nebraska.
